8:00 hrs: Departure from San Pedro de Atacama and travel to South and Northern Tilocalar volcanoes: An overview of the relation between Tilocalar monogenetic volcanoes and faults. It will be visited the eastern fringe of Salar de Atacama, and different views of Tumisa, Cordón Puntas Negras, Miñiques, Miscanti, Pular-Pajonales and Socompa volcanoes will be available.
